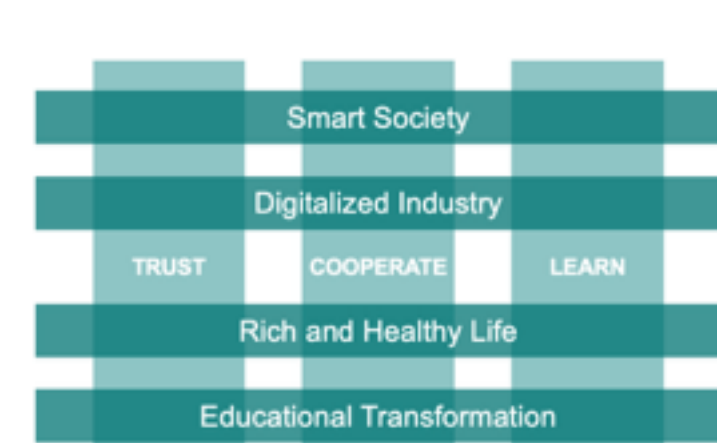


#### DIGITAL FUTURES WITH THE HUMAN IN FOCUS!

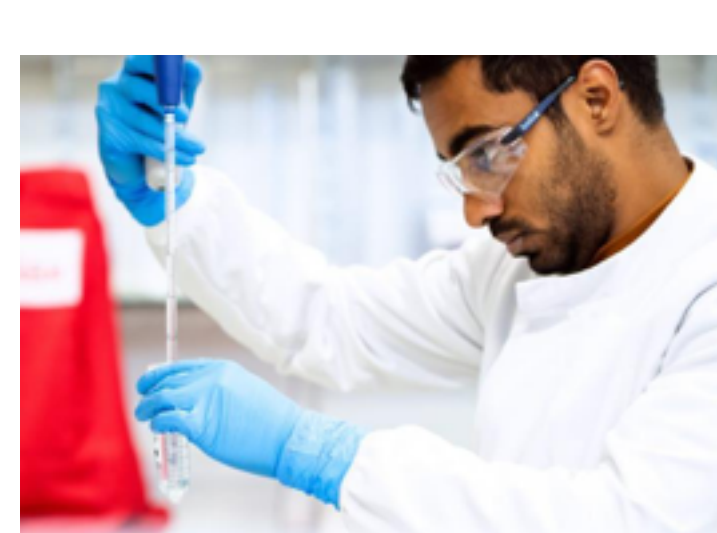

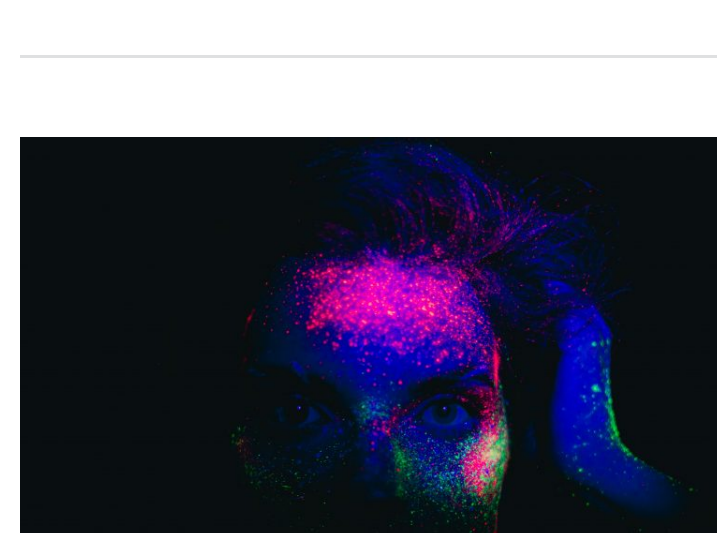

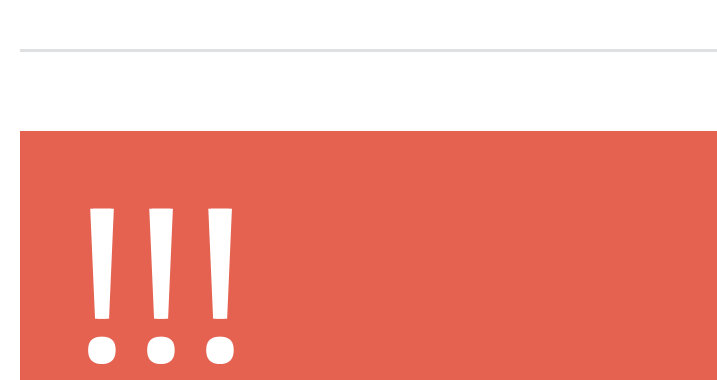
